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Choose three character traits to describe Genie. Make sure to use text evidence to support the traits you have chosen. Consider his thoughts, feelings, actions, and his words.	Make a list of five questions for which you've always wondered the answer. Then, research the answer to the questions. Create a poster showing the information you have learned.	Compose an acrostic poem using the word, "Bravery".
Illustrate the setting differences in As Brave as You. Fold a paper in half. On one side, illustrate Brooklyn. On the other, draw scenes from Virginia. Capture the details from the text in your drawings.	Create a Quote Quilt. Fold your paper in half once, then fold it again. You should now have a paper with 4 rectangles on it. In each section, write an important quote from the novel. On the back, explain the importance of the quotes you have chosen.	Compare and contrast Genie and Ernie.
